The Lasallian Foundation recognises the power of the individual to effect change.

The Lasallian Foundation follows the lead of 17th century priest and educator, John Baptist de La Salle. He was a man of strong conscience who was bothered by his family's wealth and advantage compared with the desperately poor people they lived amongst.

He left his very comfortable lifestyle to establish schools for the poor, illiterate children of Paris.

His legacy is now a network of non-denominational schools in 81 countries around the world, the majority targeting disadvantaged and marginalised children.

De La Salle was canonised as the Patron Saint of Teachers in 1900 for his visionary and innovation approach to education and his individual action is the guiding inspiration for the work of the Lasallian Foundation's Endowment Program.
